Scott Hawley is a young songwriter-songwriter-guitarist wrapped up in the modern American struggles of identity, technology and transcendence. His stories of searching for love and meaning are delivered with catchy melodies and inspiring acoustic guitar technique. Drawing inspiration from artists such as Michael Hedges and David Wilcox, Scott delivers his unique songs in a style he describes with a wink as "Rock, trying to be folk."

He returned to Austin from a two-year stint in Berlin, Germany where he headlined to packed clubs like Checkpoint and the Bebop Bar. Since then, Hawley has distinguished himself among Austin's rising crop of talented singer-songwriters by his energetic performances, both solo and with his power trio.

In 2004 he teamed up with producer Stephen Doster (who has worked with Lyle Lovett, Dr. John and Double Trouble, and others) to record five careful vignettes in the rootsy vein Austin is known for.
